**RULES OF ENTRY TO MUIRMILL EQUESTRIAN CENTRE
GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS – SMART DRESS PLEASE**

1. Competitions are organised by Muirmill Equestrian Club. Hereinafter referred to as The Show Organiser within these General Rules and Regulations
2. The Show Organiser. volunteers and officials do not accept liability for any accident, damage, injury, theft or illness to horses, riders, owners, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
3. Trespass - All visitors to Muirmill must keep to areas relevant to the show centre and are not allowed access to any other area. Anyone found to be in an unauthorised area may be asked to leave the show ground
4. The Show Organiser reserves the right to decline or exclude or remove any person or animal from the show or future show or return any entry fee without being required to assign reason or being liable for any compensation.
5. Competitions - The Show Organiser reserves the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the competitions as they see fit.
6. The judges decision is final.
7. Smoking - Smoking is not permitted within any part of the showground or buildings unless in the specified smoking area.
8. Children - The Showground is not a playground. Children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times
9. Vehicles - The Show Organiser reserves the right to remove any vehicle which is obstructing any access to or from the showground even if locked and unattended. The Show Organiser will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage occasioned by such removal.
10. Dogs - Dogs are permitted on the show ground. They must be under control on a lead at all times. If, in the opinion of the Show Organiser or any of their staff, any person fails to keep their dog(s) under control they may be asked to leave the show ground.
11. The organisers will not be held responsible for any incident or injury to riders, owners, spectators, grooms or any person or property whatsoever. It is a condition of entry that each competitor shall agree to indemnify the organiser against any legal action arising from any incident.

ANY PERSON(S) AND THEIR ASSOCIATES FOUND MISBEHAVING OR CAUSING DAMAGE WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW GROUND IMMEDIATELY

All XC fences will be of xc type but no fixed element.

ARENA EVENTING

The show jumping phase will be approx. 9-12 fences and the cross country phase will be a course of cross country style fences, some solid with knock downable top rails and ridden to an optimum time. start times will be published. Time will be judged to an optimum time, and will only come into play on equality of final scores.

We hope to run showjumping on the surface and cross country on the grass, however this will be weather dependant.

CLASSES 9am Start – Times on website from 6pm Thursday 7TH Sept

(There are no restrictions on the level of horse or rider)

If sufficient entries classes 2, 3 & 4 only, rosettes to top 3 juniors in each section. Rosettes will be awarded to 1ST to 6th Place in all classes.

Class 6 MAE 90: Dressage: P14 2006
SJ: Approx Height 90cm
XC: Approx Height 90cm

Class 6A: Jumping Section Only

All Classes Entry Fee = £18.00

Muirmill Club Members Entry Fee = £15.00

Start Fee of £3.00 payable on the day to collect your numbers and covers first aid,

COMPETITION RULES = Open to all competitors

Show Jumping and Cross Country scoring:-

Knockdown	4 penalties
1 st disobedience in each phase	4 penalties
2 nd disobedience in each phase	8 penalties
3 rd disobedience in each phase	Elimination
Fall of Horse and or Rider	Elimination
Error of Course	Elimination
Omission of obstacle	Elimination
Re-taking of obstacle	Elimination

If you are eliminated during the show jumping phase you may only compete in the cross country section at the judges discretion.

Time allowed calculated at 300 mpm for Show jumping and 350m per minute over xc section. . For every second either way of the optimum time bracket = 1 penalty. Exceeding the time limit (twice time allowed) incurs elimination.

Dress: In the show jumping and cross country phases 'colours' may be worn. **It is mandatory for all riders to wear a protective helmet manufactured to PAS 015 with Kite of higher level of protection. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap correctly and securely fastened at all times when mounted.**

Body protectors are compulsory in show jumping and cross country phases.In the event of bad weather the showjumping and cross country phase will take place in the all weather outdoor arena.
