CLEAR ROUND JUMPING - (Lead rein allowed). 10.00 am to 3.00 pm. **There may be an interval to allow the “Horse and Hound” class to take place.**

Enter on the day £5.00

(Fence Heights adjustable to suit ability)

Weigh-In

Top Spec will be available throughout the day to weigh horses and ponies and to give advice on feeding

ENTRY FEES

Entry Fee: £7.00 per class beforehand or £10.00 on the day of the Show. Fun classes £5.00. **CASH ONLY ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW.** Postal entries close **Wednesday 14th August 2019.**

Competitors entering 3 or more classes will receive a free entry voucher for *either* the Clear Round Jumping or a Fun Class of their choice.

Rosettes 1st to 6th place in all classes.

Clear Round Jumping - £5.00 per round. **Pay on the day.** All competitors completing a clear round will receive a rosette.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Committee reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate and split classes if necessary.
2. Correctly secured riding hats/ skull caps which are approved BSI standards **MUST** be worn when mounted, whether a competitor or not.
3. Colts may not be led by any Junior who has not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
4. Horses/ ponies **MUST** be ridden at walk except in the designated warm-up areas.
5. Dogs **MUST** be kept on a lead at all times.
6. The **JUDGE'S** decision is **FINAL**.
7. No competitors shall enter under a Judge who has owned, sold or received financial gain from that horse/ pony.
8. All competitors and spectators will attend at their own risk. Neither the organisers or landowners will be in any way responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants, nor any member of the public or to any animal, vehicle or property brought onto the showground.
9. Cups and trophies are perpetual and it is up to the competitor to ensure their safe return to the Show Secretary 4 weeks prior to the next year's show. Cups and trophies are engraved at the winner's own expense.
10. Inappropriate language or behaviour will **NOT** be tolerated towards other people or animals and persons responsible will be asked to leave the showground.
11. No unattended horses / ponies to be tied up.
12. No haynets on trailers or lorries.
13. Acceptance of the above provisions will be a condition of entry.
